

BYLAW 1414-2

OF THE TOWN OF WHITECOURT  
PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

A BYLAW IN THE TOWN OF WHITECOURT, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO  
REGULATE THE CONTROL AND LICENCING OF DOGS

**WHEREAS**, Council deems it expedient and proper to consolidate the Bylaws pertaining to control and licencing of dogs while making some changes.

**NOW THEREFORE**, under the authority and subject to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 1 of the Statutes of Alberta 2000, and amendments thereto, the Municipal Council of the Town of Whitecourt, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

**LICENCING**

1. That Clause 2 under Licences be deleted and replaced with the following:

That the owner, possessor, or harbourer of any dog for which a licence has been obtained under this Bylaw shall place a collar, with the tag around the dog's neck at all times the dog is off the premises of the owner.

2. That Clause 6 is added under "Licences" with the following:

That the Town shall maintain a record in which the following shall be recorded:

- a. Registration date
- b. Name, address and phone number of the owner
- c. Amount of license fee paid
- d. Breed, color, name and sex of each dog
- e. Lifetime Tag Number
- f. Proof of spaying or neutering if applicable

3. That Clause 7 is added under "Licences" with the following:

That a replacement tag will be issued to the owner upon a payment of the replacement fee.

4. That this Bylaw shall take effect upon the date of final passing thereof.

Read a second time this 28 day of SEPT, 2015.

Read a third and final time this 28 day of SEPT, 2015.
