



YOUTH ADVISORY COMMITTEE

MANDATE: To work collectively to ensure that the needs of Whitecourt's youth are met.

The Committee consists of:

- 2 Town Council Representatives
- Up to 10 student representatives from: Hilltop High School, Ecole St. Joseph School, Percy Baxter Middle School, and the community at large.

Student representatives must be between the ages of 13 and 18 years old as of December 31 of the current year.

When are meetings held?

Committee meetings are typically held on the fourth Tuesday of every month (except June, July, August and December) at 4:00pm at the Allan & Jean Millar Centre.

How much time does it take?

The time commitment varies. Committee meetings are typically an hour each month. In addition, Members are required to attend at least one Council Meeting and volunteer at four community events.

Receive a bursary of up to \$500

\$100 will be awarded for attendance at a minimum of 5 meetings.

\$400 will be awarded for:

- Participating in the coordination of a Town Hall Meeting hosted annually by the Committee.
- Mandatory attendance at a Council Meeting, followed by a verbal report on the meeting to the Committee.
- Participation in four community events hosted by the Town of Whitecourt.
