The Committee consists of:

- 1 Town Council Representative
- 1 Woodlands County Council Representative
- 5 Public Members

Public Members may be residents of Whitecourt or residents living in the Woodlands County cost-sharing agreement area.

When are meetings held?

Committee meetings are held at least quarterly and are typically held at the Whitecourt Public Library.

How much time does it take?

On average, members commit 30 hours per year.
