MANDATE: To develop and support the attraction and retention of health professionals to support the ongoing health care services to the community.

The Committee consists of:

- 1 Town Council Representative
- 1 Woodlands County Council Representative
- 1 Alberta Health Services Representative
- 1 Local Physician or Health Care Provider
- 1 Life Medical Clinic Representative
- 1 Associate Medical Clinic Representative
- 1 Nursing Professional
- 2 Members of the Public

*Public Members must be a resident of Whitecourt or Woodlands County cost share agreement area.

When are meetings held?

Committee meetings are held quarterly and typically scheduled at 12 noon.

How much time does it take?

On average members commit 6-8 hours per year. An honorarium is provided to Public Members.

Committee Role:

Develop a program that meets specific settling in and retention issues (housing, transportation, community integration) unique to the Whitecourt area.

Assist with hosting duties for community visits of potential health professional candidates.

Act as the liaison between the medical community and community at large with regard to health care attention and retention efforts.

Provide recommendations to Council on health care professionals attraction and retention.
